
Dear Member of LISA:

Connecticut Food Bank takes in food donated by growers, manufacturers, distributors, retailers and food drives and distributes it to more than 650 community-based programs throughout six Connecticut counties. In 2006, we distributed nearly 16 million pounds of food. Picture this annual distribution as roughly the equivalent of *111,000 grocery carts of food*, lined up end to end, reaching from our East Haven warehouse to Westport and back again.
